



CALL FOR ENUMERATORS

The National Technical Working Group (NTWG) in collaboration with the Southern Africa Development Community (SADC) Secretariat will be conducting a Time Release Study (TRS) at the Trans Kalahari Border Post. This study aims to measure the average release time of cargo, in compliance with Article 7.6 of the World Trade Organization Trade Facilitation Agreement. The TRS NTWG comprises officials from NamRA, various Ministries, Other Government Agencies, and the private sector.

In light of this initiative, the NTWG is currently seeking 14 Enumerators. These Enumerators will be recruited from the border vicinity and compensated by the SADC Secretariat.

Enumerator Requirements:

- Completion of Grade 11 or 12 with a minimum of 20 points across 6 subjects.
- Namibian Citizenship is mandatory.
- Proficiency in computer usage is required.
- Familiarity with surveys or CENSUS procedures is advantageous.
- Understanding of clearance and forwarding processes is beneficial.
- Individuals currently serving as clearing agents or involved in border clearance operations will not be considered for this role.

Key Dates for Enumerator Engagement at Borders:

- Tuesday, 5 December 2023, to Thursday, 7 December 2023: Training, development of Survey Sheets, and test runs to confirm data collection points.
- Monday, 15 January to Thursday, 25 January 2024: Data collection and recording.

Additional Details:

- Enumerators will receive compensation of \$50 USD per day, approximately equivalent to N\$900.
- Lunch will be provided for Enumerators.
- Enumerators are responsible for arranging their accommodations.
