NamRA Board Signs Performance Agreements

The Minister of Finance Hon. Ericah B. Shafudah and members of the Namibia Revenue Agency (NamRA) Board officially signed Individual Performance Agreements and the Governance Agreement recently in Windhoek, in accordance with Section 9 of the NamRA Act, 2017 (Act no. 12 of 2017).

The Agreements serves as a key governance instrument that outlines the roles and responsibilities of the Board and Management, while establishing clear performance expectations and accountability measures. It reinforces the Board's commitment to effective governance, accountability and the achievement of NamRA's strategic objectives and further ensures alignment with NamRA's mandate, strategic priorities and national development objectives.

Speaking at the signing ceremony, Hon. Shafudah emphasised the importance of sound governance and clear lines of accountability to support the Agency's continued success.
