The following measures will be implemented to ensure continuity of operations:

- New Clearing Agents are permitted to apply for licensing based on the existing procedures until the new Rules for the Licensing of Clearing Agents are gazetted.
- All licensed and operational Clearing Agents must reconfirm their licenses and premises, while ensuring their availability for purposes of inspections by our officials.
- Active Clearing Agents with dormant entries will be contacted in due course.
